

Player Agreement for the 2021-2022 Season

Must be reviewed and signed by the Player and a Parent

- 1) Upon acceptance to and joining New York Elite Alleycats FC (hereafter referred to as 'the Club'), I agree that the Club will be my primary soccer commitment for the entire 2021-2022 playing season and that I am obligated financially and as a player to participate in all team competitions and practices except under extenuating circumstances with sufficient notification.
- 2) Club Fees are for the entire playing season of 2021-2022. My premature departure from the Club for any reason (except for injury) does not warrant refund of Club Fees, as my participation in the Club is a soccer and financial commitment. Non-covered league fees, additional activities not already specified, tournament fees, transportation, and other expenses specific to individual teams will vary, are additional, and paid separately to each team.

I understand that the Club Fee is for the entire 2021-2022 playing season and that the total fee is (check one):

3) The total fee includes the \$250.00 initial registration fee due by 7/25/21, with the remaining balance to be paid in four equal installments in accordance with the following schedule:

- 4) I agree to make payments in a timely manner and understand that the Club has the right to withhold my official player pass at any time for non-payment or delinquency. Additionally, I understand that the Club will apply a \$25 fee for any returned checks due to insufficient funds.
- 5) If I choose to guest play for another club at a specific event, I must first consult with and receive approval from my coach.
- 6) If I choose to leave the Club, it is my responsibility to notify the coach, team manager, and registrar in writing to ensure the proper paperwork is completed to terminate my club membership and formally release my player pass.
- 7) My parent(s)/guardian(s) and I have read, understand, and will abide by the Club's Code of Conduct (see next page).
- 8) I understand that should I (player or parent) engage in any misconduct, harass, or negatively represent the Club in any way throughout the season, that it is grounds for termination from the Club.
- 9) Players are prohibited from wearing the Club's uniforms or jerseys at events not officially entered as a Club team with an official Club coach.
- 10) The Club's Commitment to You:
 - Have qualified coaches in each age group who will provide age-appropriate technical and tactical training.
 - Focus on developing the whole individual through the medium of team sport.
 - Encourage an open communication policy.
 - Ensure that the Club follows and enforces all rules as established by the leagues in which we are members
- 11) What the Club won't commit to:
 - Equal playing time. •
 - Allowing players to play the position they want at the expense of the team.
 - Compromising the greater good of the team and club to satisfy a player or parent.
 - Allowing a parent to dictate to a coach where their child plays and how much they play.

COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT - Coaches will:

- Always strive to be fair, firm, and consistent.
- Promote a positive attitude and lead by example.
- Not argue with parents and will always demonstrate good sportsmanship.
- Do their best to ensure each athlete is both physically and mentally ready for whatever task is asked of them.
- Adhere to the policies and procedures of New York Elite Alleycats FC and a set proper example for everyone to follow.
- Stress teamwork and respect for every athlete.
- Display control, respect, dignity, and professionalism to all involved with soccer. This includes, but is not limited to, officials, opponents, coaches, administrators, parents, spectators, and the media.
- Ensure that coaching or training activities take place in a safe environment and are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience, and ability of the players.
- Never strike, push, threaten, or lay a hand upon an official, player, parent, or spectator. Any act of this manner will result in immediate termination.
- Never coach or train while under the influence of alcohol or drugs or allow a player to train or play under the influence.
- Never use trash talk, profanity, obscene or vulgar language under any circumstances.
- Never demean a player with insulting name calling or vulgar language. Immediate disciplinary action, including termination, will be taken with any Club coach that displays such behavior.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT – Players will:

- Play by the Laws of the Game.
- Control their tempers, and most importantly, resist the temptation to retaliate when you feel wronged.
- Be good sports by cheering all good plays, whether it's your team or the opponent's.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated.
- Cooperate with your coaches, teammates, opponents, and referees.
- Soccer is a team sport, and players should encourage teammates; players make mistakes and have off days.
- Never abuse anyone or swear in frustration, on or off the field.
- Never use unnecessary rough tactics during a game.
- Never participate in Club activities while under the influence of alcohol or drugs. This can result in immediate expulsion from the Club.
- Always abide by the official's decision.
- Behave in a mature, responsible, and respectful manner, both on and off the field, as a team member and representative of the club.
- Refrain from using cell phones during practices and games.

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT – Parents will:

- Serve as role models for their children. Applaud good plays by your child's team as well as the opposing team.
- Not coach or referee from the sidelines.
- Not embarrass your child by yelling at players, coaches, or officials. Your child will benefit by seeing a positive attitude toward the game and its participants.
- Emphasize skill development and practice and how they benefit your athlete. De-emphasize games in the lower age groups.
- Never be under the influence of drugs or alcohol when attending games or training sessions. This can result in immediate expulsion from the Club.
- Always show good sportsmanship and set an example for your child.
- Ask your child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- Place the emotional and physical well-being of their child ahead of their personal desire to win.
- Never strike, push, threaten, or lay a hand upon an official, player, parent, or spectator. Any act of this manner will result in immediate expulsion from the Club.
- Never use trash talk, profanity, obscene or vulgar language under any circumstances.
