# **Thinking about College?**

Coach Matt Esposito, NYEAFC's College Placement Coordinator, has begun working with our sophomore, junior and senior teams as a resource to help guide their journey to college athletics. For our younger players who are looking ahead, here are some things to keep in mind:

**9th grade:** Research, Research, Research. Begin searching for colleges that offer programs of interest, appealing location, are the ideal size and offers the level of competitive play you are seeking. Utilize campus video tours or go visit as a family. Develop good study habits to keep your grades up.

**10th grade:** Work on creating a highlight reel. Keep it simple and no longer than 5-8 min. Include an intro screen with your basic information (name, graduation year, position, GPA, height & weight, what team you play for, and contact information). This should include a variety of plays that demonstrate your range as a player. Visit colleges when you are traveling for tournaments. Attend an ID camp between your sophomore and junior years.

**11th grade:** Begin emailing coaches at colleges you are interested in and invite them to watch you play. Update your highlight reel as you develop and mature as a player. Stay on top of your tournament schedule and share that information with college coaches.

**12th grade:** Stay in contact with colleges you are most interested in. Get your college applications in on time. Once you have committed, work on staying healthy and match fit.






2011 NAL player, Ezra Lester is representing the East Region as he competes in the ODP Interregional competition in Florida this weekend.







Marcello Michel transferred to Combine Academy in North Carolina and is playing in the UPSL league this spring. Good luck `Cello!




### **Ben Van Valkenburg**

























